Print this checklist and keep it handy when planning your travels

## **Planning Your Trip**

Check official government advisories related to your travel destination.

Check that your passport is valid and will not expire within 6 months of your planned trip.

Check if there are any vaccination requirements for your destination.

Refill any prescriptions that you will be travelling with.

Check if there are any visa and entry requirements for your destination.

Tell your family and friends about your travel plans, including your itinerary and flight numbers.

Travel with your Boilermakers' Benefit Card and Emergency Travel Assistance Wallet Card and share it with your travel companions.

Call the Boilermakers' Plan Administration Office at 1-800-668-7547 to confirm that you are covered for benefits.

Call Global Excel at 1-833-685-2790 (Group Policy Number: JJM00013481) to discuss any medical conditions you or your covered dependants have and any coverage restrictions prior to your planned trip.

## Your Retired Member Coverage

- Unlimited number of trips.
- 30 day trip duration maximum for retired members age 65+.
- 90 day trip duration maximum for early retirees.
- \$5,000,000 maximum per covered person, per trip.
- Top-up trip coverage is available by contacting Manulife at 1-833-685-2788.
- You must be in a stable medical condition prior to departure.
- "Stable" means 180 day pre-existing medical condition stability period exclusion applies.
- Termination age is 99.
