CHANGES TO THE HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2019 AND MAY 1, 2019

PAY DIRECT PLANS NO LONGER INCLUDE EMERGENCY TRAVEL ASSISTANCE

• Effective March 1, 2019, the pay direct benefit programs will no longer include emergency travel assistance

DOLLAR BANK DRAWDOWN CHANGES

- \bullet Effective with the benefit month of May 2019, the dollar bank drawdown will go from \$350 to \$370 per month
- The plan will subsidize member benefits at \$20 per month as the average cost of active member benefits is \$390
- Members can accumulate up to 15 months of health and welfare plan coverage in their dollar bank
